



## 2026 US Police & Fire Championships Disc Golf

Welcome to the United States Police & Fire Championships. This letter serves as your Final Confirmation of your participation in Disc Golf. Disc Golf is scheduled for Thursday, June 18<sup>th</sup> & Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup> at the Escondido Rotary Club Disc Golf Course at Kit Carson Park, located at 3333 Bear Valley Pkwy, Escondido, CA 92025. The Guiding Bodies are the United States Police & Fire Championships and the Professional Disc Golf Association.

### Conduct Expected of ALL Participants:

Drinking of alcoholic beverages, unlawful consumption of controlled substances, and gambling is prohibited while competing. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be condoned either before, during, or after competition. Any physical or verbal assaults on officials, competitors, spectators, coordinators or ex-officios will be met **with IMMEDIATE AND SEVERE PENALTIES**, including **EXPULSION** from these and future United States Police & Fire Championships.

### Competition:

Check in at 8:00 AM  
Competition starts at 9:00 AM  
Thursday, June 18-Singles  
Friday, June 19-Doubles

Each competitor must show their Participant Pass and Agency ID at check-in. A competitor not able to display their Participant Pass will not be allowed to compete. Competition will not be rescheduled or delayed if a competitor does not have his/her Participant Pass.

Athletes must provide their own discs. All discs used must meet all the conditions set forth in the PDGA Technical Standards. A disc which has been modified after production such that its original flight characteristics have been altered is illegal, except wear from usage during play and the moderate sanding of discs to smooth molding imperfections or scrapes. All discs used in play, except mini marker discs, must be uniquely marked.

### Scheduling:

Both competitions will be a 36-hole event with one round in the morning and second round beginning after a lunch break. Singles competition will take place on Thursday, June 18<sup>th</sup>  
Doubles competition will take place on Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup>.

### Scoring:

Singles-  
Individual stroke play. Gross scores only. The score for a player on a hole is the total number of throws, including penalty throws. The total score for the round is the sum of all hole scores, plus any additional penalty throws.

2-Person Team-  
Scored by Best Throw (example)

- Teammates 1 and 2 throw from the tee.
- T1 lands not too far from the basket. T2 lands out of bounds.
- The players choose to play from the lie near the basket.
- T1 misses the put, T2 makes it.
- The team chooses to take the made putt.
