The Guiding Bodies are the United States Police & Fire Championships and the United States Golf Association.

Conduct Expected of ALL Participants:

Unlawful consumption of controlled substances, and gambling is prohibited while competing. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be condoned either before, during, or after competition. Any physical or verbal assaults on officials, competitors, spectators, coordinators or ex-officials will be met **with IMMEDIATE AND SEVERE PENALTIES, including EXPULSION** from these and future United States Police & Fire Championships.

Hard copy scorecards will still be required for the verification process to Golf Genius.

GOLF RECEPTION & AWARDS:

There will be a Golf Awards Reception on Thursday, June 18 from 5:30 PM-8:30 PM at Coronado Golf Course, 2000 Visalia Row, Coronado, CA 92118. Lunch will be provided, and your first drink is on us. (Registered golfers only)

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Your handicap will be checked via the internet. By submitting your Membership Number on your application, you will not have to mail a copy of your Handicap card. If your Index Number cannot be verified through your association or through the internet using the information you have provided, you must email a scan of your Handicap card, showing your Index Number, to USPFC staff. Send to: Jose Meraz at jmeraz@cpaf.org.

If your handicap cannot be verified, The handicap committee will determine your final handicap.

YOU MAY PARTICIPATE IN EITHER SCRATCH OR HANDICAP, BUT NOT BOTH.

DRESS CODE:

A dress code for all players will be strictly enforced. Golf style shorts or skirts with a minimum of 5" inseam are permitted. All golfers **MUST** wear shirts with collars. Only shoes with rubber spikes are allowed. If you are using metal spikes, make this change before you arrive for the first day of competition.

PROHIBITED:

No tank tops, halter tops, tube tops, short shorts, cut offs or jeans are permitted. Steel spikes, suction sole shoes or thongs are not allowed on the golf courses. No dogs on courses. No jogging on golf course or golf course paths during golf course open hours. No loud music.

Each golfer may not have more than 14 clubs.

No blackberries, laptop computers, or any other electronic equipment can be used while on the golf course. The only exception is "range finders". All USGA GPS approved range finders can be used.

MAXIMUM SCORE PER HOLE: No more than 10 strokes will be counted on a hole. Pick up and move on. Pace of play will be monitored.

REMINDERS OF GOLF RULES DURING PLAY:

During play, not more than Three (3) minutes may be used to look for a lost ball. Golf Marshall will enforce this rule.

All putts must be finished. There are no "gimme" putts (except if your gross score is over 10)

No Individual or two-person team or persons from their own agency will keep their own scores. All Individual or two-person teams must exchange scorecards with the other team in the foursome or with one of the singles playing in that foursome.

No mulligans or improving of lies.

No possession of or drinking of alcoholic beverages will be allowed during competition.

Correct, signed tournament scorecards must be turned in immediately after each round to verify Golf Genius score.

Scoring discrepancies will reflect the higher score recorded.
