



2026 US Police & Fire Championships Sporting Clays

Welcome to the United States Police & Fire Championships. This serves as your Final Confirmation of your participation in Sporting Clays. Sporting Clays is scheduled for Wednesday, May 20th, at LA CLAYS, 831 Rosemead Boulevard, South El Monte, CA 91733. The Guiding Bodies are the United States Police and Fire Championships and the National Sporting Clays Association (NSCA).

Conduct Expected of ALL Participants:

Drinking of alcoholic beverages, unlawful consumption of controlled substances, and gambling is prohibited while competing. Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be condoned either before, during, or after competition. Any physical or verbal assaults on officials, competitors, spectators, coordinators or ex-officiis will be met **with IMMEDIATE AND SEVERE PENALTIES**, including **EXPULSION** from these and future United States Police & Fire Championships.

Registration:

This event offers onsite registration. **AGENCY IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED.**

Registration/Check-In and Shotgun Practice - LA CLAYS will be open on Tuesday, May 19th from 10:00 AM until 3:00 PM for registration/check-in and practice. Practice targets are the responsibility of the competitor.

Start Time: 10:00 AM, Wednesday, May 20th at LA CLAYS, 831 Rosemead Boulevard, South El Monte, CA 91733.

Check-In Time: 8:30 AM. All competitors will Check-In on-site at least 60 minutes prior to their scheduled time to help move the event along in an orderly/timely fashion.

Scheduling information will be available at on-site registration; OR, by contacting the sport coordinator. See contact information at end of this letter.

CLASSIFICATIONS:

There will be "A" and "B" Divisions.

- Individual (Unisex)
 - A Division (72.0 and above)
 - B Division (below 72.0)
- Team (Unisex)
 - One Division only (5 Person)
- High Overall Shotgun
 - A Division
 - B Division

CLASSIFICATION: Shooter classifications will generally follow the NSCA guidelines for determining classification, with the exception that the USPFC only offers two categories for competition, A & B divisions.

If competitors do not possess a current NSCA classification, or who has not previously competed in the USPFC or the World Police and Fire Games, will be assigned to A or B division based on the following:

The competitor will be classified on the 100 Individual Event targets. The competitor will be classified on 50 Individual targets chosen on the predetermined 5 out of the 10 stations used during competition. The score will be doubled, and the competitor will be classified based on the above listed Divisions. The Classification that is established will be used from that point forward or until the competitor obtains a current NSCA classification.

Competitors who do not possess a current NSCA classification and who previously qualified for A or B Division may be reclassified to B or A Division if their scores for the 2 previous USPFC or World Police and Fire Games events in which they competed would qualify them for the specific division.

EQUIPMENT:

Shotguns are provided by the competitor, 12 gauge or smaller, capable of firing two (2) shots.

Ammunition must meet NSCA standards and is provided by the competitor. Reloaded ammunition is acceptable, provided it meets NSCA specifications. Ammunition will be available for purchase from the range for \$125/case (10 boxes) or \$15/box of 25 (tax included)

Venue Requirement on Ammunition:

7 ½, 8 or 9 shot lead only

No 12 gauge ammo faster than 1250 fps on the American Trap and Skeet fields

Nothing over 3 DRAM is allowed

1 1/8 oz of shot is max

Reloads are allowed pending testing by the venue. Please be prepared to provide the recipe.

SQUADS & TEAMS:

All squads will be a maximum of 5 people. No exceptions.

GENERAL RULES:

Please refer to our website at www.uspfc.org;

All shooters MUST enter the Individual event even if they only want to compete in the Team event.

Individual: Each shooter attempts 100 clay birds.

Team score is aggregate of Team members' Individual scores.

High Overall Medal: A set of medals will be awarded in two divisions ("A" and "B" Division) for the best combined scores in the individual events in Trap, Skeet and Sporting Clays. To be eligible for this award, the competitor must be entered into the 6 individual events in Trap, Skeet and Sporting Clays, AND enter the "High Overall" category in Sporting Clays.

REGISTRATION & CHECK-IN REQUIREMENTS:

AT EACH DAY'S CHECK-IN, ENTRANTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SHOW CURRENT AGENCY IDENTIFICATION CARDS. If your agency identification does not have a photograph, you will also have to present photo ID, such as a driver's license. Retired entrants without retirement identification may substitute a letter from their agency's Administration or pension/retirement board to satisfy the agency identification requirement.

PLEASE NOTE: On-Site Registration is allowed ONLY in specifically designated sports. If you are entered into another sport or event(s) in the Games which does NOT allow On-Site Registration, you must appear at Host Headquarters Registration in order to receive your Participant Pass prior to your first competition in that sport/event. Without this Participant Pass, you will not be allowed to compete in your other events.
