Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be condoned either before, during, or after competition. Any physical or verbal assaults on officials, competitors, spectators, coordinators or ex-officios will be met with **IMMEDIATE AND SEVERE PENALTIES**, including **EXPULSION** from these and future United States Police & Fire Championships.

Important Note:

There is a **MANDATORY** Team Captain's meeting Wednesday, June 17th at 7:00 AM at Sportsplex Santee. A representative from each team **SHALL** be present. If the captain can not attend, send someone from your team, even if you have a later game. No excuses will be excepted. It is the responsibility of the Captain to disseminate the information to their team members. Captain's must immediately notify the Sport Coordinator if there are any errors in the participant information. Captain's are responsible for making sure that every player on their roster has paid the appropriate entry fee and is an eligible player. **FINAL ROSTERS MUST BE SUBMITTED AT THIS TIME.**

Competitors may compete in both Indoor and Outdoor Soccer, but if a conflict in games' schedules occurs due to a competitor entering both sports, the competitor must choose the sport he/she will compete in. The USPFC WILL NOT adjust game schedules to accommodate individual competitors/teams. The USPFC WILL NOT refund entry fees due to a scheduling conflict.

BRACKETING:

Pool Play - Round Robin followed by Single Elimination Playoff tournament format. Due to 16 teams entered into the Men's tournament this year, there will be two playoff divisions, A & B. The top two teams from each pool will advance to Division A, while the bottom two teams will advance to Division B. Both Divisions will be awarded medals at the conclusion of the single elimination tournament.

SPORT RULES:

Teams: Each team shall start the tournament with a maximum of 12 players and a minimum of 4 players. Each team is permitted 1 non-playing coach. Each team must start every game with a minimum of 4 players on the field, one of whom must be the goalkeeper.

There is a free substitution.

Duration of Game: The game shall consist of two (2) 22-minute halves, with a 1-minute break between the halves.

Dress of players shall be consistent with USISA and USPFC Rules.
